‘Oliver Lee Jackson: Force Field’

One of the few living Bay Area artists awarded a major exhibition at the National Gallery of Art in many years (the Washington show ends Sept. 15), Oliver Lee Jackson is finally getting his due. After teaching at California State University Sacramento for many years, the 84-year-old artist is now able to devote all his time to painting and sculpture. This show of new work will allow us to see the latest permutations in his method, which has typically woven vaguely figurative images into abstract webs of action and color.
